


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

A brief overview of Kien Giang province, Vietnam

Kien Giang province is located in the southwest of Vietnam, covering an area of 6,346 km². Current population is 1.73 million people in which Kinh ethnic is over 85% and Khmer is about 12%. Kien Giang has 15 district-level administrative units.

A brief overview, cont.





- -Bordering An Giang, Can Tho and Hau Giang provinces to the northeast.
- -Bordering Ca Mau and Bac Lieu provinces to the south.
- -Bordering the Gulf of Thailand to the southwest, with over 200km of coastline and islands.
- -Bordering Cambodia to the north with 56.8km of the borderline.

A brief overview, cont.

- -Kien Giang's fishing grounds is an area of 63,290 km². Kien Giang has 143 islands, with 105 large and small floating islands. Among these, there are 43 islands being inhabited by people.
- Mineral resources are the most abundant in the Mekong Delta region including peat, limestone, building stone, clay, iron, lateritic iron, quartz – opal,....
